Now a reference in eco-responsible events and sustainable development, the Palais has drawn upon the latest innovations to continue enhancing its environmental performance.



takes many forms:

- Adoption of practices to reduce water consumption, manage waste, use LED lighting and maintain heating, ventilation and air conditioning systems aiming for LEED Canada EB O&M certification.
- Applying an ambitious action plan, in accordance with Québec's Sustainable Development Act.
- Investing \$1.2 million to continue a project for saving energy.
- Reducing greenhouse gas emissions by 39% since 2005.
- Keeping more than 185 tonnes of waste away from disposal sites in 2010, equal to 37,000 garbage bags.
- Providing continuing training to the team and support for the local community through programs such as annual corporate volunteer activities.
- Promoting local cultural heritage by exhibiting artwork and through participation in special events.



Far-reaching actions

Culti-Vert: an unprecedented success!

The Palais has originated a genuine international showcase of best practices in green roofs with its Culti-Vert project. This initiative involves developing a 5,770-square-foot space as a green roof and vegetable garden in containers.

In addition to helping reduce downtown heat islands, Culti-Vert has produced a harvest of 650 kg of organic vegetables and fines herbes to enhance convention-goers' dishes, along with 10% provided to community organizations.

As a special player in the community, the Palais actively supports the green shift in the area of tourism and conventions. In particular, it:

- Helps develop the Québec standard in responsible event management.
- Plays a role on the Green Committee of the Montréal tourism industry.
- Endorses the Montréal Community Sustainable Development Plan 2010–2015.
- Involves the CQEER to guide its clients in holding eco-responsible events.
